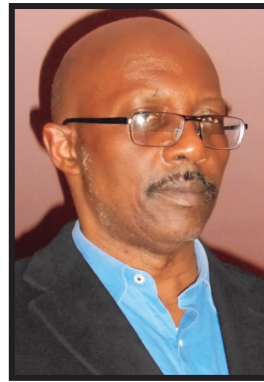


Brian Lehman - Young & Committed!

Our Curriculum

Classes at NEIE are focused on our vision: **“Committed to establishing seed sowers for the kingdom through classroom theory, and practical application, that they may learn to teach others to teach (Mt. 28:18-20; 2 Tim. 2:2).”**

Each class will build upon the next giving the student an holistic understanding of Scripture; church history; hermeneutics; etc., all geared toward the student being equipped to comfortably teach others .

While students are learning, they are challenged to apply themselves in personal work. Practical application is vital to our program. Learning the Bible without doing the work is not what we are about at NEIE. We are a **“Go as you Grow...Grow as you**

Go” school. **The student is connected with opportunities to do local, out of state, and or overseas mission work. Participation is a necessary part of the curriculum, when studying formally, and or informally.

We have ten **required** courses to graduate from the program. Currently the student has the option to attend on Monday evenings or Saturday mornings.

Courses taught are:

1. Introduction to Bible Study
2. Introduction to Evangelism/ Missions
3. Old/New Testament Survey
4. Church History
5. The Scheme of Redemption

6. Dealing with Arguments/ Intro Christian Apologetics

7. Biblical Interpretation/Intro to Hermeneutics

8. The Authority of Christ

9. Denominational Doctrines/ Islam

10. Evangelism & the Life of the Soul Winner

***NEIE is a non-profit institution.** Each class is **tuition free**. The only cost is for text books, and class materials, (i.e., handouts, binders).

NEIE Offering Three Ways To Study:

1. **Formal—10 classes consecutively in two years; out of state, or overseas work; certificate of graduation when completing all required course work.**
2. **Informal—Choose classes you prefer, certification for individual class completed.**
3. **Audit—Choose a class, study with us, build your knowledge.**

While taking the formal, and or informal path of study, students are required to be involved in local evangelistic outreach. There is optional out-of-state, and or overseas work available to those who choose to go. All are encouraged to take advantage of these works, and are taught how to raise the funds for the mission.
