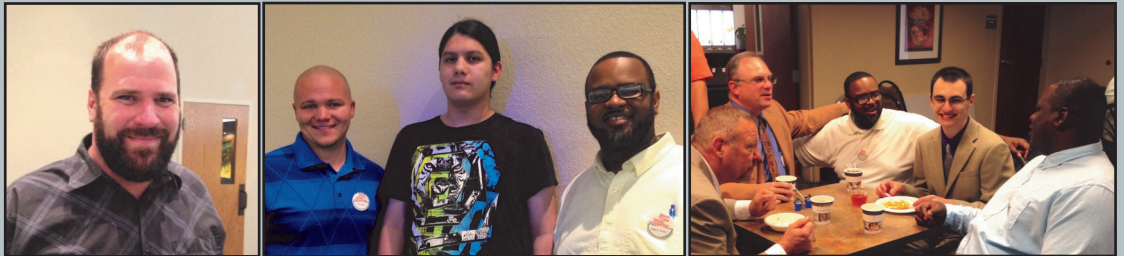

To Seminole and Back!

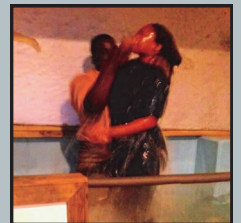


Chris Oslin—a new member / Jessi, in the middle was baptized—Troy and Kenneth taught / Morning breakfast & fellowship

From May 30th to June 3rd three students and two NEIE instructors joined hands with at least seventy five more soul winners to work in Seminole, OK. It was the 40th consecutive “Back to the Bible Campaign” Northwest has held, with the Seminole Church of Christ hosting the effort. Brothers Gregg and Brian Lehman, Kenneth Spence, Issac Prince, and myself were able to travel to OK and serve reaching out to the lost, not only in Seminole, but also in the Holdenville, Wewoka & Tecumseh area’s. Unfortunately, two of our current students were

not able to join us due to conflicting work schedules. With all the workers on the street we were able to set up 150 studies, 50 of those were taught during the campaign, 37 were left with the congregation to follow up on; 17 souls obeyed the gospel and 1 soul was restored! The Seminole congregation did a wonderful job serving all that came from more than several states to help in the effort. The campaign family said that they were very encouraged by the wonderful work the students performed. All of us were involved in setting up studies,

several taught, and with NEIE’s particular efforts 5 souls were added by the Lord. The evangelistic fervor continued when arriving back home, two more souls obeyed. Kenneth taught and baptized his sister in law, **Kandace Vaughn**. Issac preached his first lesson at Chester and **Shaquda Gosset** came forward to be baptized! Please keep the new Christians and NEIE in prayer. RD

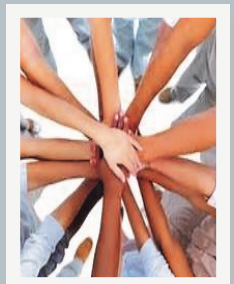


What Is NEIE All About?

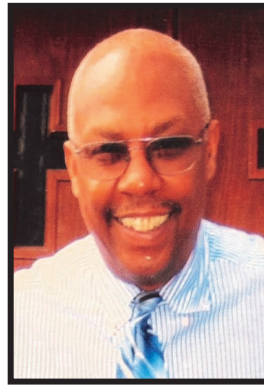


William Anderson—Dedication



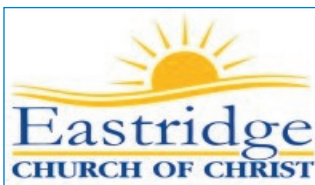

Our Curriculum

Classes at NEIE are focused on our vision: **"Committed to establishing seed sowers for the kingdom through classroom theory, and practical application, that they may learn to teach others to teach (Mt. 28:18-20; 2 Tim. 2:2)."**

Each class will build upon the next giving the student an holistic understanding of Scripture; church history; hermeneutics; etc., all geared toward the student being equipped to comfortably teach others .

While students are learning, they are challenged to apply themselves in personal work. Practical application is vital to our program. Learning the Bible without doing the work is not what we are about at NEIE. We are a **"Go as you Grow...Grow as you**

Go" school. ****The student is connected with opportunities to do local, out of state, and or overseas mission work. Participation is a necessary part of the curriculum, when studying formally, and or informally.**

We have ten **required** courses to graduate from the program. Currently the student has the option to attend on Monday evenings or Saturday mornings.

Courses taught are:

1. Introduction to Bible Study
2. Introduction to Evangelism/ Missions
3. Old/New Testament Survey
4. Church History
5. The Scheme of Redemption

NEIE Offering Three Ways To Study:

1. **Formal—10 classes consecutively in two years; out of state, or overseas work; certificate of graduation when completing all required course work.**
2. **Informal—Choose classes you prefer, certification for individual class completed.**
3. **Audit—Choose a class, study with us, build your knowledge.**

While taking the formal, and or informal path of study, students are required to be involved in local evangelistic outreach. There is optional out-of-state, and or overseas work available to those who choose to go. All are encouraged to take advantage of these works, and are taught how to raise the funds for the mission. (See below *)

***NEIE is a non-profit institution.** Each class is **tuition free**. The only cost is for text books, and class materials, (i.e., handouts, binders).
