The first course is **Introduction to Bible Study**, The emphasis in this class is to develop in the mind of the student the big picture of Scripture. Periods of Bible history are covered; one word thoughts, and or phrases are memorized for each book of the Bible. Students learn to analyze, and outline books and chapters. They also learn about tools that will help with deeper study, along with a minor introduction to Biblical hermeneutics.


